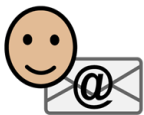
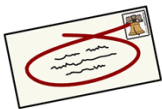

## Western Bay Integrated Autism Service



The Integrated Autism Service (IAS) works with autistic adults, their family members and anyone with a supporting role (including professionals). We also offer support to the parents/carers of autistic children and young people.

Anyone can refer into the Integrated Autism Service.

Western Bay includes Swansea, Neath Port Talbot and Bridgend.



## Integrated Autism Service



The Integrated Autism Service provides direct support for autistic adults. We also provide advice, support and signposting for parent carers of autistic children, young people and adults.

**Adults can self-refer for an assessment if they think they may be autistic.**



**Autistic adults who have received a diagnosis at any point in their life can access the service for:**

- support to understand autism
- **short-term** direct support
- support to access other services which may include employment, education, health, leisure and recreational activities.



**Professionals from any service can contact the IAS for:**

- consultation, advice and support on how to tailor interventions in an autism friendly way.



## Integrated Autism Service



The Integrated Autism Service also offers:

- Post Diagnostic Support Courses
- Autism Advice Hubs –these are accessible for anyone with an autism related query

The service **will not** accept referrals for:

- direct work with children
- emergency or crisis intervention
- respite care
- diagnostic assessments for people under 17 years 9 months
- prescription or monitoring medication
- long-term input or care management.



**Other services are available to help with these issues.**
